

Parents please remember that drop off is between 8 am and 8:30 am. If you are going to be later than 8:30 am please call the Head Start, so the teachers know to expect your child for breakfast.

Nutrition and Your Child:

Preschool children are at an age when nutritional habits are formed. It is essential that the whole family is on board in order to establish healthy eating habits.

1) Make it a point to eat as a family when possible. Remember to keep the television and personal devices from the table. 2) Frozen and canned fruits and vegetables are just as healthy as fresh. Look for frozen and canned foods that say "no added salt or sugar" or packed in water. 3) Have water, fat free, or 1% milk with every meal. 4) Preschoolers need snacks. Try to limit snacking to fruit, veggies, and low sugar yogurts.

And most importantly every food is good in moderation!

Benefits of recycling abandoned vehicles

Old vehicles that are no longer in use account for a substantial part of our environmental waste. Recycling these vehicles is beneficial to the environment, it reduces the emission of greenhouse gases. Recycling old vehicles provide enough steel to produce almost 13 million new vehicles every year and saves an estimated 85 million barrels of oil each year. Recycling your old parts can save retail customers about 50% when purchasing used parts over new parts. By recycling old unwanted vehicles it will reduced 62% of waste and reduced landfill by 35%. These are some benefits of recycling old vehicles. Not only are you putting money in your pocket, you will be protecting our ecosystem and wildlife. Every year, U.S. landfills are filled with 139.6 million tons of waste, including:

- 30.63 Million tons of food.
- 26.82 Million tons of plastic.
- 18.35 Million tons of paper and Paperboard.
- 13.8 Million tons of metals.
- 12.14 Million tons of wood.
- 8.65 Million tons of yard trimmings.

What is Composting

Composting is an easy way to turn you waste into useable material. Brown + green = material like leaves straw and shredded wood along with grass and vegetable scraps combined with water air and high temperatures creates, environment for materials to break down. It enriches our soil helping to retain moisture. Reduces the need for chemicals

Climate Change Water Conservation

Climate Change impacts the world's water in many ways. Warmer air can hold more moisture than cool air. As a result, in warmer weather, the air will suck up more water from the oceans, lakes, soil and plants. In drier conditions the air will have an impact on our drinking water, water supplies, agriculture, and farm animals.

We will be reducing transports to one day a week. Please make sure that you schedule your transport as soon as possible. To schedule an appointment please contact:

YOUR APPOINTMENT MUST BE MADE AND VERIFIED WITH THE CAP DEPARTMENT BEFORE YOUR SPOT CAN BE RESERVED FOR THE TRANSPORTATION SERVICES. SCHEDULE APPOINTMENTS ONLY WITH SAIGE RILEY 24 HOURS PRIOR FOR LOCAL TRANSPORTS AND 1 WEEK IN ADVANCE FOR FRESNO TRANSPORTS.

The transporter will wait 15 minutes after your scheduled departure. If you do not arrive on time, your appointment will be canceled and can be rescheduled with Saige Riley only. There are new rules for the transportation services, please call the transporter for a copy of revised rules. Transportation services are for Big Sandy Rancheria Tribal Members.

The transporter cannot transport kids to school that have missed the bus. All CVIH appointments are to be scheduled with CVIH transporter. If the CVIH transporter is unable to transport you, they will need to reschedule your appointment. This applies to all medical, dental, nutrition & referral appointments.
