Where Does Your Trash Go?

Do you ever wonder where your trash ends up? Your trash could end up in one of many places, depending on how you dispose of the items. Recyclable trash, for example, is sorted and sent to a recycling center.

So, What happens to trash at Big Sandy, after it's thrown away?

- Your trash is picked up and taken to the transfer station at Big Sandy
- Your trash will be taken to the landfill in Friant California. Landfills must be located away from the city for environment reason.
- The best-case scenario, the trash will be incinerated, and the process this entails will generate the energy that feeds your local power grid

Still various steps must be taken to reduce trash and make and make it disappear in the most sanitary way for our environment

What is outdoor Air

Outdoor air –the air outside buildings, from ground level to several miles above the Earth surface-is a valuable resource for current and future generations because it provides essential gases to sustain life and it shields the Earth from harmful radiation. Air pollution can compromise human health and the environment in many ways for example, outdoor air pollution:


- Can contribute to "acid rain"
- Can impair visibility and damage crops
- Is associated with a number of human health effects including heart attacks, asthma attack, bronchitis, hospital and emergency room visits, loss of work an school, restricted activity days, respiratory symptoms, and premature mortality.

Somethings you can do to help clean air is: walk, bike, carpool, make your house more efficient.
