Munahoo Neum,

Tzow Takasakonin, Good July. With Independence Day upon us, we do want to remind you that there are NO FIREWORKS allowed here on the Rancheria, nor are they permitted on the U.S Forest. There are events taking place with celebrations of Independence Day, where fireworks can be admired.

We appreciate everyone taking every effort to conserve water, as we are not out of the clear just yet. Please, if you have any leaks in your home, toilets, sinks, coolers, or faucets, call the Tribal Office. We are so appreciative for the pallets of water donations we received from Cold Springs Rancheria, Table Mountain Rancheria, Central Valley Indian Health, American Red Cross, and Pepsi Co. If you need bottled water, please call the Tribal Office. We do want to remind everyone that during our summer months, we do not have a sufficient supply of water for swimming pools or playing with hoses to cool down. Please be mindful and not waste our supply, which will affect everyone on the water system.

The Tribal Council has appointed three Tribal Members to the Election Committee. Rebecca Riley, Melissa Perez, and Darrell Telles. We appreciate these three for stepping up and volunteering to be on the election committee. As a reminder we do have Tribal Council elections in September, so please keep your eye out for information on the upcoming deadlines from the election committee.

Gaming Compact Update- our Gaming Compact is still pending the approval of the State of California Legislature but have a period of mid-July for it to move through. Once the Legislature approves, it then will flow to the Secretary of State California for its attestation and submitted to Department of Interior Bureau of Indian Affairs for review and approval. Like always, thank you very much for your time and energy, have a blessed rest of your month.

## BIG SANDY RANCHERIA SOCIAL SERVICES DEPARTMENT

**Social Services Department Update-** Hi BSR Nation- we have updates from the Social Services Department. We have a new staff member working in the Social Services Coordinator role, Stephanie Casillas. The Department is overseen by Kip Bowmar, the Director of Planning and Development. He can be reached at [pddirector@bsrnation.com](mailto:pddirector@bsrnation.com) or 559-374-0066 ext. 225 or 559-955-1163. Feel free to reach out to either of us if you have questions about a particular program.

**Social Services Department Programs-** The Social Services Department works to support BSR's Tribal families by ensuring they have services, assistance, and support. By working with each individual and family we can identify their unique needs and help access resources to address them. Our goal is to encourage, promote, and maintain the overall health and well-being of Tribal Members and their families. Specific programs we operate include:

**Tribally Approved Homes-** Federal law requires that placements of Indian children are made according to the prevailing social and cultural standards of the Indian community and also allows Tribes to approve or license their own homes. BSR has been active in advocating for child welfare and recognizes the need for appropriate tribal foster and adoptive homes. For families that are approved as either foster or adoptive homes, there are additional resources available to them. Families or individuals who decide they would like to assist in this way can reach out to find out more about the application process.

**Mark Your Calendar for the Tribally Approved Homes Seminar August 22nd from 11:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m.** If you are interested in learning more about becoming a Tribally Approved Home, plan on attending an informational seminar Aug. 22 at 11:00 a.m. at the BSR Community Resource Center located at 33041 Auberry Road 93602. BSR is partnering with the Fresno American Indian Health Project (FAIHP). Lunch will be provided. Registration materials will be out soon. **ICWA-**The ICWA Rep will intervene in eligible child dependency cases involving Tribal Members and their children. This includes Tribal representation in court, case management, and service referrals.

**Victim Advocacy-** This includes connecting people with resources and helping them connect with culturally appropriate services available through BSR as part of the healing process.

**Educational Outreach-** Presenting information at BSR and other community events to let BSR members know of services available to them. The Social Services team participated in the Missing and Murdered Indigenous Women and Relatives (MMIW/R) ceremony and proclamation at the Fresno City Hall on May 2<sup>nd</sup> and at the BSR Pow Wow on May 18-19 and will continue to participate in community outreach events.

**Flexible Family Supports-** For families and individuals that are already approved as foster care homes, there are additional resources available to cover expenses like respite care, participation costs for children in enrichment activities including sports and arts that benefit the child's development, and activities that are designed to help the child connect with family members.

**Substance Use Disorder Services-** Counseling, both one on one and in group sessions from a certified counselor for substance use disorder is now available at the Auberry Community Center located at 33041 Auberry Road. The program is operated in partnership between Fresno American Indian Health Project (FAIHP) and BSR. Call 559-320-0490 ext. 605

**Partnership with Community Allies-** In addition to partnering with FAIHP, BSR is also partnering with FAIHP in the Medicine Wheel 12 Step Classes that are held every other Tuesday from 12-1 and the Sacred Circle every other Tuesday from 2:00pm to 5:00pm. Both classes are offered at the Community Resource Center 33041 Auberry Road. There is additional information about each program in the newsletter.
